Dear Judge Stivers,

My name is Bobby Lewallen and I wanted to ensure my character statement about Faraday was available to the court. I am a West Point graduate who served 10 years in the Army, followed by a 17 year career as a Johnson and Johnson operations manager, and I have owned and operated my own businesses for the last 20 years. In my experience I have met and worked with a lot of people, and I can say without reservation that Faraday is one of the best I have ever met personally or in business. I don't say this lightly. She is an incredible businesswoman, who leads by example and always puts other people's interest and wellbeing first. With I2G she promoted the opportunity with integrity, and tirelessly trained people to do the same.

I met Faraday when I joined I2G back in 2014 and if she is guilty of the chargers levied against her, then so is every other independent business owner (IBO) that joined and promoted the I2G opportunity. I am not privy to what evidence was presented in the court room, but Faraday joined I2G because she believed in the company, the management, the incredible products, and the belief that anyone who joined the I2G family or who used the I2G products would benefit greatly.

In this instance Faraday and all I2G/G1E IBOs are the victims, but not victims of I2G/G1E. The company had incredible products many of which would have been first to market, and they paid IBOs for marketing / introducing those products to others. Products included online gaming (gambling is now legal in 48 states except Hawaii and Utah), fantasy sports (FanDual, Draft Kings), Songstergram (bBooth), and G1E Touch (Zoom, FB, etc) just too name a few. Yes I2G/G1E failed but I can personally testify that the company was growing with incredible excitement until we were attacked (80% of my group for example) by Chuck King and an overzealous FBI agent that he recruited to his fraudulent cause. Once Chuck King started attacking the company online and contacting our members with false accusations it was just a matter of time before the company failed. We all lost everything but that was not because Faraday or other iBOs did anything wrong or illegal.

In summary, I believe that if given proper representation and a fair trial that Faraday would be exonerated of all charges. In a fair world the people truly responsible for the collapse of I2G/G1E would be held responsible instead of Faraday. As I stated above, I have never met a better or harder working individual than Faraday.
