You didn't get a chance to know my daughter, Faraday Hosseinipour, even though you probably spent two months together in the court room. I would like to tell you about her. She has never been an officer or owner of a network company. As a distributor, she has even paid for people's initial investment so they have a chance to earn money from home.


She is beautiful with twinkling brown eyes and a contagious smile. When she laughs, every one laughs. She is honest, truthful and extremely loyal to a fault. She never says a negative word about anybody and never gossips. She accepts people as they are and is never judgmental. Her communication skills belong on TV. She loves all animals and would never harm them, even bees and wasps. She feeds all the strays, ducks, opossums, birds, and whatever else shows up. She has two chihuahuas and four cats. She would adopt more, except her husband Dave, has a limit. Her hobbies are biking, swimming, exercising at the gym, and caring for sick animals.

Her daughter skills are every parent's dream. If I or her father needed help, she would drop everything and drive from FL to KY to help. This even persisted after her father died. When I sold my home, she and Dave took time to help me sell, pack and move to FL. which took a month out of their own lives. She helps me tremendously especially since I am almost 77 and do have some medical conditions that do warrant extra assistance that is not available to me as an on-call service. To save me from paying a professional painter, she painted the complete interior and exterior of my home. She removed all the nails from the cement to lay vinyl flooring.

First, I have a bowel disorder since 2006 when part of my bowel was removed. This disorder makes me lose my electrolytes immediately and I have to lay on the floor in fecal material until she comes to help me. Also, in 2006 I had a post-surgical heart attack and should not over-exert myself. My right should joint is slightly separated from my clavicle causing a severe weakness in my right arm. At times I cannot lift my right arm or use my right hand to write. I have painful arthritis in my lower back, hands, and knees which causing mobility issues. She will do my errands at that time. Although I hate to admit this sometimes, I get confused and do not understand what is going on.

I need her at home to care for me but mostly I love her and hope she can be with me always.
