TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

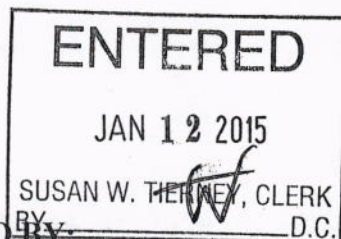
This matter having come before the Court on the motion of Plaintiffs for a temporary restraining order against Defendant Charles "Chuck" King, the Plaintiffs having appeared by counsel, and it appearing that the rights of Plaintiffs have been, are being or will be violated, and that Plaintiffs will suffered immediate and irreparable harm if the requested relief is not granted, and it appearing that Plaintiffs' counsel has complied with CR 65.03(1)(b) regarding its efforts to notify Defendant, and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's motion is **GRANTED**. Defendant King is hereby restrained from (a) making any remarks, publications, or comments, on any and all print, electronic, and/or online media, during the pendency of this action, which in any way characterize, disparage, discredit, or spread false information concerning Plaintiffs; and (b) continuing or maintaining his disparaging, defamatory, and discrediting remarks (including on video posts) on any and all print, electronic, and/or online media during the pendency of this action and to keep them removed permanently.

Pursuant to CR 65.05, this order shall be effective upon the posting of a bond of

\$ 5,000⁰⁰.
